Port of Duqm Company would like to inform all its visitors to read and become familiar with the following safety principles to avoid any accidents or incidents in the terminal area.

A. General Safety Principles

1. Unaccompanied pedestrians are not allowed on the terminal.
2. When allowed, the visitors will have to wear a safety helmet and a high-visibility vest.
3. Terminal equipment shall always have priority over other traffic.

B. Principles Applicable to Vehicle Drivers

1. All vehicle drivers have to comply with PDC's procedures (see Operational Procedures – Gate Operations).
2. Carriage of passengers is prohibited.
3. During a stay at the gate in/out with a container on the trailer, the driver shall switch off the engine.
4. The driver is not allowed to switch off the engine or park between stacks or in any other places within the terminal not indicated as a parking area.
5. All road signs on the terminal have to be respected. The driver may never take shortcuts. The vehicle should be driven at a safe speed, adapted to the prevailing conditions, and in any case the maximum speed may not exceed 30 km/h.
6. The vehicle shall stop at each exit from any yard stack blocks.
7. The vehicle shall always have the dipped lights on.
8. For the purpose of proper loading/unloading of a container, the driver shall park the vehicle in the requested position and cooperate with the terminal personnel without leaving the cabin.
9. Using of cell phones or any other devices is forbidden during the stay at the terminal.
